

Virtual Creativity

How to innovate with the help of a smart sharing system

Here's a way of virtually confronting challenges in a defined network of people:

1. Leader (or leadership group) defines a challenge and invites people (team members) to participate in the network.
2. Team members write down as many solutions as they can imagine. They are encouraged to be as imaginative as possible, everything is allowed. They do not have access to what others have written.
3. Team members gain access to what everyone has written. They add more facts but do not interact.
4. Team members chat and interact virtually on what has been written. Some ideas may be modified
5. Leader may decide to launch another phase of idea generation/collection, in which case repeat steps 2, 3 and 4.
6. Team members vote for best solutions and generate a longlist.
7. Leader generates a shortlist.
8. Team members comment and discuss pros and cons of each shortlisted solution - one solution at a time.
9. Team members vote on best solution.
10. Leader makes final choice of best solution

The above process is asynchronous, people work and contribute at their own time. The process would be further enriched with preparatory steps to agree on key facts and the context of the challenge and also to redefine the challenge precisely. And after step 10 there should be further steps to ensure implementation. The system could also measure each person's effort in terms of number of words and solutions and comments offered. Team members and Leader can offer pats
